Maintenance

Maintenance of your new GeneralAire[®] SL16 Legacy Flow Through Humidifier is minimal. To ensure peak performance and reliable operation, simply change your Vapor Pad[®] once per year and clean mineral deposits from the water pan. A solution of 1/2 vinegar and 1/2 water is suggested. Water Intake Valve

- Brings water into unit and to the distributor trough.

(Inside)

- Ensures every square inch of the Vapor Pad® is covered for consistent evaporation throughout.

Bypass Duct

- Mount to left or right.

Water Drain Tube

- For automatic draining of water from unit.

Solenoid Valve Assembly

Cover Tab (Found on Both Sides at Top)

- Slightly lift bottom of tabs up / out from unit to "swing" cover open and down for easy maintenance of unit.

How Much Humidity Do I Need?

Ideally, your home's humidity levels should stay between 40% and 60%. Outside that range, your risk of being adversely affected increases.

Winter Settings

During winter months, be sure the water supply is turned on, your damper control is set to "Open" or "Winter", and your humidistat is set somewhere between 40% and 60%.
